Following the Town Council meeting held on 22nd July the following information maybe of interest to the residents of Llanfair Caereinon.

Playground

The new playground in Llanfair Caereinion is well into construction stage. The opening date for the new playground is Friday 5th August.

There are new swings; with facilities for disabled and families, a new disabled friendly roundabout, a small child's slide, and new surfacing. In addition, much of the existing equipment (climbing frame and larger slide) has been refurbished.

Dog control in Deri Woods and The Goat Field

The Council has received comments from some people who walk their dogs in Deri Woods about threatening behavior from other dogs. This does not appear to be a widespread issue and sometimes it is caused by dogs being a little boisterous. New signage will be installed reminding people to keep their dogs under close control.

Deri Woods and The Goat Field Management Plan

Deri Woods and Goat Field is the only Council-owned site listed as a habitat of principal importance for Wales (under Section 7 of the Environment (Wales) Act 2016). It is home to seven species of tree of principal importance to Wales

The Council has been working with the Deri Woods Volunteers to put together a management plan for Deri Woods to ensure it is well kept for future generations. This will mean some felling of trees to ensure others are allowed to grow. The full plan can be found on the Council's website at www.llanfairtowncouncil.co.uk

There will be a few consultation days planned for the autumn where residents can take a tour of Deri Woods and see what is proposed. The dates will be published in due course.

Deri Woods and The Goat Field Meadow

The Friends of Deri Woods have gained a grant to enable re-instatement of a meadow to be created around the stones. This will allow for indigenous species to grow and help with biodiversity. The Council has agreed to part fund the project to enable it to progress with the support of the grant aid and the volunteers.

Parking Review for the Town

The Town Council has been involved with the County Council is a parking review for Llanfair Caereinion.

The Councilors are to host a walk around the Town to meet residents who are interested in each area. Dates for this will be published soon.

The Council will then come to a final conclusion at its September Council meeting.
