Introduction

Cllr Wyn Williams Chair of the Council said 'this is an exciting time for the Council and Llanfair as much is now moving forward. Some of the projects are well under way with the Wales Keep Tidy scheme and the Town Trail. With so much planned we hope that the Town will see a change over the next 12 months to make it a great please to live.'

Tidy Town and Town Trail

Works to create a Town Trail are progressing well with some information boards already in place. Alongside this the Town is having a spruce up. The finger signposts, railings, bollards, notice boards and benches have almost all been repainted and refurbished along with town clean ups.

Polinator Garden

Keep Wales Tidy provided a Polinator Garden to help wildlife. It has been installed in Erw Ddwr in Watergate Street in the garden of remembrance. The works to install the garden were completed in partnership between the Town Council and the High School. The garden will be maintained so that the plants will aid pollination and the environment.

Lighting St Mary's Church

The church lighting is currently provided by sodium lights which are expensive to run and are coming to end of their life. The Council is taking forward a scheme of LED lighting which will reduce the running cost by approx 80%.

The lights will be 32 colour which will allow the church lighting to look the same as now on most days but will also allow the church to be lit in colour for events. For example the British Legion Poppy Appeal could be in red or on St David's day white, green and red. The aim is to have this work completed during October 2021.

Free WiFi in the Town

The Council has met with Powys County Council to investigate a Smart Towns initiative. This will provide at no cost a WiFi system throughout the Town from the Railway Station to Deri Woods and part way up Mount Road and Watergate Street. The system will give free WiFi to all who visit the Town including local residents. More news soon.

Tree works at St Mary's Churchyard

Works along the High Street in St Mary's churchyard have taken place to coppice the trees to keep them healthy, clear the lines entwined with them and prepare them for the Christmas Lights event in December.

Youth Council

The Llanfair Caereinion Youth Council is born and will meet every quarter to consider subjects of interest and ideas to be put to the Council for consideration. This will give a good voice to the young people and hopefully help gain better facilities for them.

Defibrillator Plan

A plan to provide defibrillators in the Town is being taken forward. There will be such units at the new school and new doctor's surgery in time. There is a Town Council unit going into the telephone box at Watergate Street with other locations identified in Market Square and Mount Field.

Town Plan

The Town Plan consultation is drawing to a close at the end of September. The plan has an action list which comprises those things the Council wishes to achieve in the life of the plan including target dates for completion. The High School took part in the Town Plan consultation earlier in September. The Youth Council will provide their own plan to add to the Town Plan. A full report on the consultation and final plan will be presented to Council in November.
