2.2.3 Comments about transport arrangements

2.2.3.1	Concern that under the current transport policy, English- medium pupils wouldn't have transport provided to their nearest English-medium school.	As stated in the Consultation Document published in respect of this proposal:
		'The Council's Home to School Transport Policy states that if pupils are eligible for free home to school transport, the Council will provide this to their closest or catchment school. If pupils live closer to Ysgol Bro

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Caereinion but choose alternative schools instead, then they won't be able to access free school transport and would need to make their own transport arrangements.'
Based on this policy, transport wouldn't be available for pupils wishing to access alternative English-medium provision instead of accessing Welsh-medium provision at Ysgol Bro Caereinion.
However, it is acknowledged that the proposed transport arrangements in relation to this proposal, and the lack of transport to alternative English-medium provision, have caused concern in the local community. The Council will need to consider this when deciding whether or not to proceed with implementation.
