



A Youth Club for Llanfair Caereinion

Introduction

The Llanfair Caereinion Town Plan was adopted on 8th November 2021 with an action plan attached. Within the action plan is the ambition to provide a sustainable youth club for the Town with a target date of June 2022.

This paper set out a way forward to meet that commitment.

Advice

Advice has been sought from Powys County Council, existing local youth providers and other experienced persons involved (currently or in the recent past) with the youth of the area.

Current provision

The current provision for youth in the town comprises the local football club and a weekly youth event run by the Community Church.

There is an ad-hoc provision through Young Farmers.

Over the past 10 years the town has seen previous provision cease (i.e. Scouts, Guides, Army Cadets etc).

Need

There is a need for a youth club demonstrated by:

- i) Advice from the Town Council Youth Form at the High School.
- ii) Advice from those involved in youth work in the area.
- iii) Lack of facilities for young people in the town.
- iv) Social Media survey.

Location

There are two potential locations as follows:
