# 16.1 Planning application - Oak Beech Valley Farm Llanfair Caereinion,

Application for a Certificate of Existing use in respect of the use of land for storage and residential purposes. This application for a certificate of existing use was refused and has now become the subject of a planning appeal.

The Town Council offered no comment at the time of the planning consultation.

The Council is asked to confirm if they wish to make any representations to the appeal inspector.

### 16.2 Tanyfron, Broncafnent Lane, Llanfair Caereinion

A development for 3 new homes with 1 being social housing has been consented. The application is a Section 73 application to remove conditions 5, 6 and 7 included in planning permission 20/0010/OUT in relation to national and local policies and guidance and previous planning decisions/appeals and to vary condition 14 in relation to national policies and guidance and previous planning decisions/appeals on the removal of permitted development rights. (all new homes free of social housing restrictions)

This application has now become the subject of a planning appeal.

The Town Council response to the consultation was as follows:

The meeting considered the request to remove an affordable housing provision. The meeting OBJECTS to the application to remove conditions 5,6 and 7. The reason being that affordable housing is essential to the community. The Council also wishes to point out in their concern about suitable access to the site.

The Council is asked to confirm if they wish to make any representations to the appeal inspector.

APPENDIX A

#### **ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR**

The procedure to be adopted for the election of both Chair and Vice Chair at this meeting is set out below:

- i) A nomination paper will be issued to each member present on whom you are asked to nominate the person you would like to see as Chair or Vice Chair for the ensuing year.
- ii) If there is only one name that person is elected.
- ii) If there is more than one each will be asked if they wish to stand. First the Chair will be asked, then the Vice Chair and then in alphabetical order.
- iv) If there is two or more an election shall take place.
- v) The votes will be counted and if a candidate receives more than 50% of the vote there is only one round. If the person with the highest votes has not reached 50% then the person with the lowest votes drops off and vote is taken with the remaining candidates.
- vi) When there are only two candidates left it is a simple majority.
- vii) The voting shall be by secret ballot.

At the annual meeting the Chair shall wear the Town Chain of Office. It the current Chair stands down him/her will present the incoming Chair with the Chain of Office.
